On Saturday, March 26, 2011, a rally will be held in support of the release of Benjamine Spencer. The rally will take place at 9:00 a.m. on the front steps of the Frank Crowley Courts building at 133 N. Riverfront Blvd. (corner of Riverfront and Commerce).



Ben has been incarcerated for more than two decades for a crime he did not commit. As a result of Ben's incarceration, he was stripped away from his loving family leaving his pregnant wife to raise their son without a father. As late as March 2008, Judge Magnis of the 283rd District reviewed the case and found Ben to be innocent of the charges that led to Ben losing 24 years of his life in prison. Yet, to date, Ben still sits in a prison cell waiting to be reunited with his family.

What if this happened to you and your family? Would you want others who knew of your innocence to do nothing? We passionately believe that we are collectively responsible for Ben's incarceration through the election of our government officials and the payment of our taxes. Please join us so that our voices can be heard and we can work together to end this injustice.
